The United States has reported 67 million COVID-19 cases since the pandemic began. With the pandemic we have to make sure that we are staying safe to prevent catching COVID-19. The Virginia Department of Health has set up free COVID Testing in Suffolk. Local Rite Aids, Walgreens, and CVS also provide COVID testing as well. Vis-

it **COVIDtests.gov** for information on free tests that may be available through government services. Listed are a few more facts about COVID and How to Stay Safe During the Pandemic:

- **Limited Contact**: We are preventing limited contact, staying 6 feet apart, and washing your hands. Make sure you are still practicing social distancing and staying masked up. Our office is still **closed** for walk ins but if you have an appointment with a caseworker then please make sure you are masked up when entering the building.
- Masking Up: Masks help limit the amount of respiratory droplets that go into the air to help stop the spread of COVID-19. Doctors, nurses and other medical staff have been wearing face masks for decades. Disposable masks should be thrown away if they become wet or dirty, and should only be used one time. Cloth face coverings should be washed.
- Avoid poorly ventilated spaces and crowds: If indoors, bring in fresh air by opening windows and doors, if possible. If you are at increased risk of getting very sick from COVID-19, avoid crowded places and indoor spaces that do not have fresh air from the outdoors.



# Free Paid Internship with Hope for Suffolk



Hope for Suffolk invest in teens through there farm work program and personal development workshops. Interns gain work experience, income, job training, community and a positive use of time. Interns attend weekly workshops (with dinner provided!) for which they receive community service hours. The workshops cover every-

thing from conflict resolution to making good impressions to budgeting to interview skills. The program runs from **March through October**. For young adults **between ages 15 and 20**. Their goal is to empower youth to overcome obstacles and to set and achieve personal goals.

While interning students can earn up to **\$10 per hour** while getting real work experience. They can earn community service hours, meet great people, and become empowered to become who you want to be. Participants will leave the program with life-long relationships, connections with employers, a resume, and training for success. They also will have scholarship opportunities that will help out as well.

Please keep in mind you must first register with a valid email address to be granted access. Please remember your user ID and password. In addition, you can communicate directly with your caseworker and there is a record of any documents you

upload. This will eliminate the need to visit the office. We are streamlining things making the process contactless and safe. This is a reliable method of doing business considering Covid-19 restrictions.
