We are embarking on exciting times with our for the online portal. Due to the Coronavirus (COVID-19) restrictions, this is an awesome way to update your information for annual reexamination, interim changes, and upload documents. This is also a secure way of proving information to your caseworker directly and a way of tracking any documents submitted to our agency. You will have access to your account electronically. This will give you the ability to keep your records updated at all times.

We strongly encourage you to register at our website **www.suffolkrha.org./pay-online** to register for an account. Click the tab to pay online. This will open you to the registration page. Once, registered you will be able to upload document to your caseworker as well as make changes to your application. Please keep in mind you must first register with a valid email address to be granted access.

Please remember your user ID and password. In addition, you can communicate directly with your caseworker and there is a record of any documents you upload. This will eliminate the need to visit the office.

We are streamlining things making the process contactless and safe. This is a reliable method of doing business considering Covid-19 restrictions to ensure your information is secure and confidential. Thank you for your full cooperation in our efforts to better assist you. — **HCV Department**

Suffolk Public Schools Summer Food Service Program

Suffolk Public Schools is participating in the Summer Food Service Program. Meals will be provided to all children without charge and are the same for all children regardless of race, color, national origin, sex (including gender identity and sexual orientation), disability or age, and there will be no discrimination in the course of the meal service. Meals will be provided, on a first come. first serve basis, at the sites and times as follows:



- Hillpoint Elementary School, 1101 Hillpoint Rd, Suffolk, VA 23434, Monday-Thursday (July 5-August 4, 2022)Breakfast 7-9/Lunch 11-12:30
- John Yeates Middle School, 4901 Bennetts Pasture Rd, Suffolk, VA 23435. Monday-Thursday (July 5-August 4, 2022) Breakfast 7-9/Lunch 11-12:30
- Nansemond River High School, 3301 Nansemond Pkwy, Suffolk, VA 23434, Monday-Thursday (July 5-August 4, 2022) Breakfast 7-9/Lunch 11-12:30
- Kings Fork Middle School, 350 Kings Fork Rd, Suffolk, VA 23434, Monday-Thursday (June 22, 2022 (3:00-6:00p.m.) July 5-August 4, 2022) Breakfast/Lunch 10-12

In accordance with federal civil rights law and U.S. Department of Agriculture (USDA) civil rights regulations and policies, this institution is prohibited from discriminating on the basis of race, color, national origin, sex (including gender identity and sexual orientation), disability, age, or reprisal or retaliation for prior civil rights activity.

Affordable Connectivity Program

The Affordable Connectivity Program is a \$14.2 billion program that supports eligible low- income households struggling to afford monthly internet service. This critical program ensures that households have the connections they need for work, school, healthcare, and more. Eligible households can also receive a one-time discount of up to \$100 to purchase a laptop, desktop computer, or tablet from participating providers if they contribute more than \$10 and less than \$50 toward the purchase price.

The Affordable Connectivity Program is limited to one monthly service discount and one device discount per household.

Who Is Eligible to Receive ACP Support? A household is eligible if a member of the household meets at least one of the criteria below:

- Has an income that is at or below 200% of the federal poverty guidelines;
- Participates in certain assistance programs, such as SNAP, Medicaid, Federal Public Housing Assistance, SSI, WIC, or Lifeline;
- Participates in Tribal specific programs, such as Bureau of Indian Affairs General Assistance, Tribal TANF, or Food Distribution Program on Indian Reservations;
- Is approved to receive benefits under the free and reduced-price school lunch program or the school breakfast program in the current or immediately preceding school year;
- Received a Federal Pell Grant during the current award year; or

How Does an Eligible Household Enroll in the Program? There are two steps to enrolling in the ACP:

Complete and submit an online or mail-in application available at ACPBenefit.org.

2. Contact a participating provider to select an internet plan and have the ACP discount applied

FAMILY SELF-SUFFICIENCY

Family Self-Sufficiency is a program which offers housing assistance as part of a coordinated linkage to other programs and services to include child care, transportation, personal and career counseling, adult basic or college education, job training and job placement assistance.

The goal of the FSS Program is to assist highly motivated persons to become economically self-sufficient (i.e., self-supporting by obtaining employment and/or education without receiving city, state and federal assistance). Any SRHA Housing Choice Voucher (HCV) client and/or Public Housing residents. The FSS Program Staff will help you ac-

cess your needs and direct you to those resources that will enable you to move forward in becoming self-sufficient.
